





### Lower School, Grades K-3rd

# Elementary through High School, Grades 4-12

## Fun Weekly Workshops PLUS Academic Advancement!

Each morning, students will have the opportunity to take a morning sports class, and then an academic study period. Use this academic time to:

- get ahead academics
- do extra courses
- get help with a problem subject
- sharpen study skills, and more!

Each afternoon, choose two different workshops ("A" from 2:45-2:00 and "B" from 2:15-4:00).

These workshops are delivered on a rotating basis, sometimes only once or twice during the summer, and others will be delivered almost every week. Most workshops have limited space and will be filled on a first-come, first-served, basis. Once at capacity, it will be closed. Any workshops with insufficient enrollment will be cancelled, and students will be able to choose a different workshop that week.



 Academics—offered every week, morning and afternoon. Use this time to learn and sharpen study skills, improve in math, get ahead in reading, tackle chemistry, or even get a head start on the fall term.



- Art—A variety of art classes will be delivered throughout the summer. There will be at least one choice each week. Some of the offerings are:

#### **Sports Camps**

Soccer Camp — Morning period during Week 4 (July 9-13) and Week 7 (July 31-Aug 4). Students will be able to practice and hone basic skills, and play scrimmages to work on team and individual skills.

<u>Basketball Camp</u> — Week 8 (August 7-11) in the morning period. Students will learn plays and take part in learning drills to fine tune their skills on the court. Those skills will be tested in daily scrimmages.
